Removing Persystent Client

Steps to remove Persystent Client

- 1. Check to see that "Persystent Client" is installed in Add/Remove Programs.
 - a. If yes, uninstall it.
 - b. If not, go to step 2.
- 2. Go to services.
- 3. Stop Persystent Client Service.
- 4. Go to Disk Management and delete Persystent partition if exists.
- 5. Run **CMD** as an administrator.
- 6. Type in command: SC DELETE "Persystent Client Service"
- 7. Hit Enter.
- 8. It should notify that the service was uninstalled successfully.
- 9. Type in command: rd c:\windows\persystent /s /q
- 10. Hit Enter.
